## European Directive 2011/65/EU (ROHS) and delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863

Giovenzana International B.V. leader in the Lift, Handling and Automation Sectors, in the realization of the all components required on LIFT, applies the EU legislation on the "Restriction of hazardous substances" (RoHS) of 2015 (in the current version - Directive 2015/63), adopts the provisions of the European Parliament and of the European Council on restrictions on the use of dangerous substances in the construction of electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS 3) .This directive entered into force on 22 July 2019 and establishes that all newly produced electrical and electronic equipment introduced on the market, within certain product categories (with some exceptions), must not plus contain the following chemicals beyond the specified maximum concentrations:

- Lead (0,1 %)
- Mercury (0,1 %)
- Cadmium (0,01 %)
- Hexavalent chromium (0,1 %)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0,1 %)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0,1 %)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0,1%)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0,1%)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0,1%)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0,1%)

Giovenzana International B.V. will work closely with its suppliers and customers to ensure that full compliance with the RoHS directive is always achieved.

Any information from Giovenzana regarding the RoHS status of its materials will be provided, based on information transmitted by manufacturers and suppliers, or resulting from internal or external tests.
